## **Obituary – Dennis Beckett**

"With deep sadness Greenlands CC report the passing of Dennis Beckett, President and founder member of the original St. James Club, in early June after a long and plucky fight against cancer. A sterling example of his generation, brought up in World War 2, he was a robust yet likeable character with a good sense of humour and a keen interest in the game of chess and in encouraging others, especially younger players (notably Keith Arkell, now a G.M.). Dennis's forte was organisation and under his leadership St. James was one of the largest and strongest clubs around, competing in BDCL, Worcester County and District leagues, winning several trophies and one year achieving the "triple". When he finally laid down the baton he was voted life membership and became our first President. His stalwart presence will be sorely missed". L J Wheatley

## **Registrations: A Note of Caution!**

Many of the the registration entries in this Bulletin have been transcribed, re-transcribed, cut, pasted, amended, added to, moved, deleted, and generally messed around with, sometimes by more than one person. I and others have occasionally corrected what we considered to be obvious typos and mistakes in the submissions from Club Secretaries, but it doubtful that we have found all the errors, and we may have added extra mistakes of our own. It would be a miracle if there are no howlers in the printed details. I would therefore be grateful if Club Secretaries would check the entries for their clubs, and if individual members would check the spellings of their own names. I will publish any necessary corrections in Bulletin 2. For the first time I have listed member's first names where available. However, for space-saving reasons it is my current intention to revert to initials when listing match results, except where I am aware of possible ambiguities. Ed.

## **BDCL Web-Site(s)**

Mike Rees, Web-site Manager, requests that all Club Secretaries read the relevant entry for their Club on the Midlands Chess Web-site, and send him any amendments that they would like to make. Mike has also raised the question of whether the BDCL would like to establish its own separate web-site, perhaps with commercial sponsorship and/or with paid links to commercial organizations. (These options are banned under the terms and conditions of the current web-site, but they might be a way for the BDCl to generate income plus raise its profile.

## **Grading Bonanza?**

Feeling undervalued? Then you could be in luck! The English Chess Federation's graders are likely to be upping the grades of most chess-players on their database. The reason is a perceived disparity between ECF gradings and international ELO grades. The extent of the disparity varies according to the strength of players grades for 2008 were published to give organisers data (the stronger you are the less you will benefit), but many of us could be receiving an unexpected early Christmas present of from 1 to 50 grading points. Of course the sad thing is that all your club-mates and rivals will be getting an upgrade too .... The provisional new gradings can be found on the English Chess Federation Website. However, Dave Thomas, sounds a note of caution:

"Dear All'.

Can I please emphasise to EVERYONE that the "new" grades on the ECF web site are NOT OFFICIAL for ANY PURPOSE for the current season.

The Federation's intention is to publish official grades on the revised basis in July 2009. The provisional revised to enable them to decide how they should readjust the grading limits for their events taking place in the 2009/10 season.

I'm afraid that in a misguided rush to meet an arbitrary deadline insufficient care was taken with the drafting of the explanation, which has led to the current confusion".

## **School Chess**

The English Chess Federation has received a donation from a wealthy benefactor that should result in all(?) schools being able to apply for a number of free chess boards. Details of how the scheme will work are still unclear.

<u>Match and Adjournment Reporting</u> - John Fahy, Joint Records Secretary, writes (with editorial amendments):

- (1) <u>Emailing:</u> As indicated at the AGM, the Records Secretaries are willing to accept adjournment results (*but not initial match results*) by e-mail as follows:

- (3) <u>Match Cards</u>: However, please note that emails are still *not acceptable* for reporting the initial results of matches. Match Cards are required from every Club in respect of ALL matches even in the event of a match default by that Club.
- (4) <u>Late Results Penalties</u>: It was unfortunately necessary to enforce Rule 9.1 (see Handbook) on two occasions last year. Please help the Records Secretaries by sending in match cards promptly. The Records Secretaries do not put a 5 day clock on each match and it is only the seriously late cards that will be flagged up. In addition, on the third occasion of a Team submitting a late card, that Team's Club Secretary will be notified so as to help the Team/Club avoid a penalty under Rule 9.1. It is therefore entirely the Team's and Clubs responsibility if they fail to avoid such a penalty.
