### Grading and Rating

Eligibility for grade-restricted sections will be determined by the January 2018 ECF Rapidplay grading list. All sections will be ECF graded and FIDE-rated. The following priority will be used for section allocation and seeding:

- (1) ECF Rapidplay Grade
- (2) March 2018 FIDE Rapidplay Rating (converted using the formula:  $(FIDE - 700) / 7.5$ )
- (3) ECF Standardplay Grade
- (4) Other Rating Assigned by the Organiser

### Ungraded Players

Ungraded players must give details of estimated playing strength. Ungraded players who cannot demonstrate a playing strength appropriate for their section must play in the Open.

Pairings will be made according to FIDE Pairing Rules by the Swiss Manager computer program.

### Disputes

The Chief Arbiter's decision shall be final in all disputes relating to the either the Laws of Chess or Swiss pairings.

### Accessing Quinborne Community Centre

#### Car

The nearest motorway junction is M5 Junction 3. From there, take the A456 towards Birmingham. At the junction with the A4123, turn right onto the A4123. At the next island, turn right into Ridgacre Road, and the centre is 100 yards along the road on the left-hand side. Travellers from the north will have a quicker journey from M5 Junction 2. From there, take the A4123 towards Birmingham. At the first island after the junction with the A456, turn right into Ridgacre Road, and the Centre is 100 yards along the road on the left-hand side.

#### Bus

The 24 bus stops at the Centre. Services depart from Colmore Row, stop SH1, in Birmingham City Centre. This is 100 yards from Birmingham Snow Hill railway station. Services are half-hourly on Sunday mornings. Sunday services that arrive in time for round 1 depart at 0835, 0905, 0935 and 1005.\*
