Report of the Rules Committee meeting held on Thursday 9th November at Mutual Circle Chess Club.

1. The Scrutiny Committee (D. Brelsforth, D. Thomas & Rob. Reynolds) had instructed South Birmingham to re-register C. Charman from their 1B team to 1A because his grade was 20 points higher than the lowest graded player in 1A. South Birmingham had appealed against this request.

South Birmingham gave a number of reasons for not wishing to comply with the Scrutiny Committee's request. The registered 1A team was the same side that had become League Champions and they wanted to keep the side together; they wished to retain the same Captain; and they would also have some difficulties with transport arrangements since they had only 2 car owners. There was also some concern about integrating a much younger player within an adult team and in addition, South Birmingham expressed doubt that the published grades were a true reflection of the abilities of some of the players concerned.

The Committee considered that the grades as published were representative of the players concerned and that a gap of 20 points was much greater than the accepted norm.

The Committee ruled:

Whilst the Committee has every sympathy with South Birmingham's selection problems, and can appreciate their arguments, we nonetheless feel that there are good reasons to uphold the Scrutiny Committee's decision in principle, that 1 or 2 players be re-registered to Division 1A. On the basis of their grades the Committee feels that C. Charman and/or S. Tidman should be re-registered to 1A. We also uphold the Scrutiny's Committee's decision that, should they wish to do so, South Birmingham may register to Division 1B, G. Varnom, J. Mildenhall or D. Dunn.

2. Terry Walker as Chairman of the Match Committee requested, at the Summer Management Meeting, that the Rules Committee be instructed to look into the possibility of changing Rule 7.1. At its last meeting, the Match Committee had wanted to consider the possibility of dropping Division 8 and amalgamating the remaining teams into Division 7. However, Rule 7.1 states that the lowest division must have 4 players per team.

The Rules Committee proposes the following amendment to Rule 7.1:

Delete "four players" and substitute "with at least four players. The Match Committee shall have the right to decide the number of players in each team in the lowest division each season".

The Committee realises that Clubs may have difficulty with entering a team in the lowest division expecting to need only four players when the Match Committee may increase this number. Therefore, should this rule amendment be accepted, the Rules Committee requests the Hon. Gen. Secretary to alter the League Entry Form to require clubs entering teams in the lowest division to give information as to whether they could raise a team of more than four players if necessary.
